

CF&I Hall of Fame Selection Scoring Rubric & Criteria

Criteria

- Biographical Overview (150-word limit) includes rationale for nomination. **(10%)**
- Nominees must have been employees of CF&I or subsidiary (mills, mines, company store, etc.) prior to 1993, when the company ended.
- The nominee’s employment at CF&I significantly enhanced their life and the lives of those around them. **(60%)**
- The nominee has demonstrated service to the Pueblo community. **(20%)**
- The nominee has displayed exemplary achievement in the nominee’s area of specialization; to include honors and awards. **(10%)**
